GENERAL

The EU Digital COVID Certificate aims at facilitating safe free movement during the COVID-19 pandemic within the EU. It is a digital proof that a person has been vaccinated against COVID-19, received a negative test result or recovered from COVID-19. The certificate may be used in all EU Member States, as well as in Island, Lichtenstein and Norway.

The EU Digital COVID Certificate contains only necessary information such as Name, Date of Birth, Issuing Authority and the unique QR identifier.

In order to issue the EU Digital COVID Certificate you must visit the <https://eudcc.gov.cy/> portal and follow the necessary steps.

Once the EU Digital COVID Certificate is issued, you may store it on the CovPass Cyprus application available for Android and iOS smart devices. The app is available in Greek and English, for Android 8.1+ and iOS 12.1+.

USER'S GUIDE

Users with Android devices can download and install the CovPass Cyprus application from Google Play (<https://play.google.com/store/apps>).

Following successful installation of the CovPass application on your smart device, you can take the following 4 steps to recover and store the EU Digital COVID Certificate.

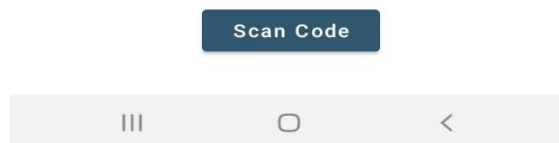
ANDROID DEVICES

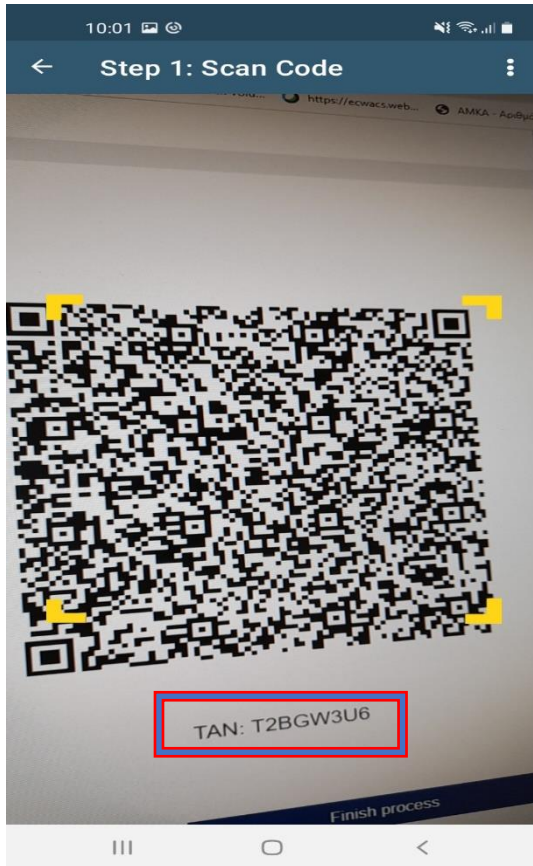


Picture 1: CovPass Cyprus Homepage

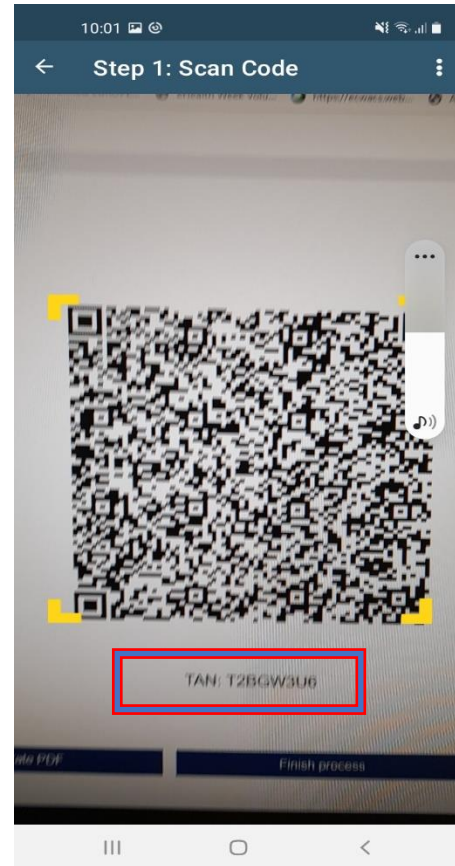
To initiate the recovery/storage procedure, click on «**Scan Code**».

STEP 1: SCANNING THE QR CODE

To scan the QR code, move the camera of your smart device so that the yellow borders cover the QR code (See Picture 2).

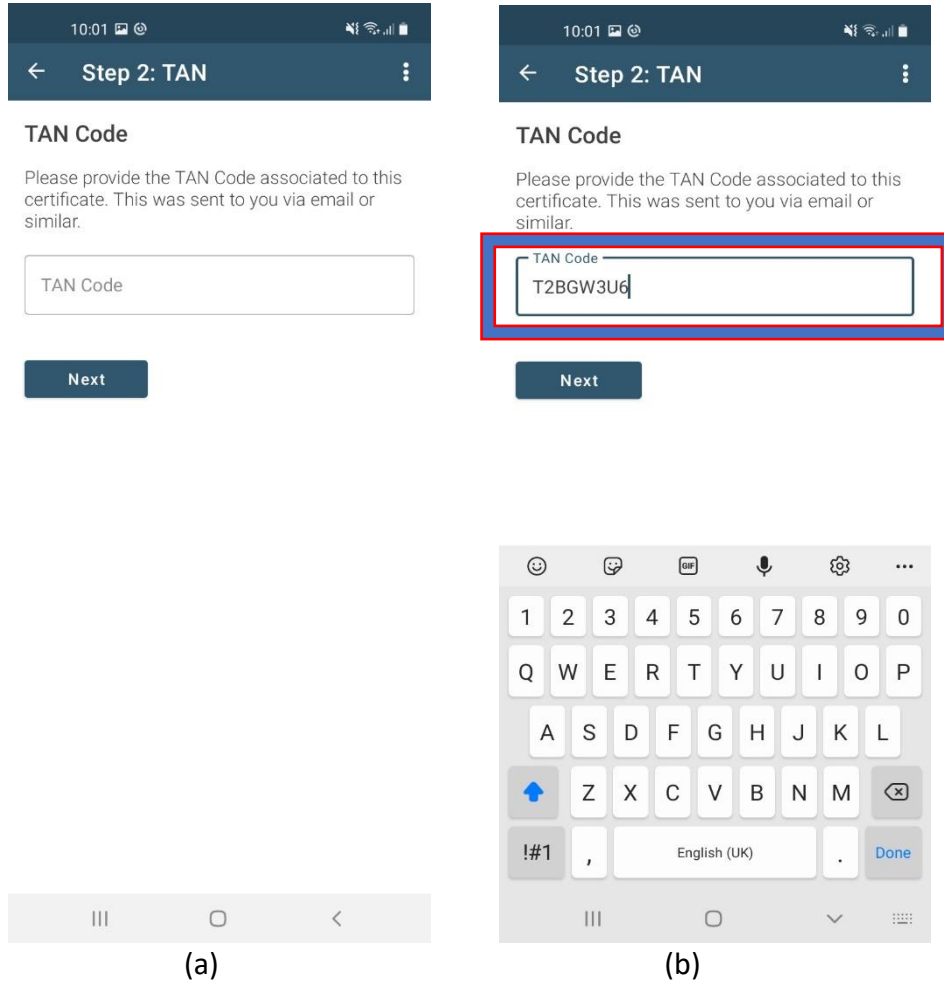

STEP 2: INSERTING THE TAN CODE

After scanning the QR code the application will ask for the unique 8-digit TAN code marked under the QR code.

***Note:** Make sure that the TAN code inserted is the correct one.

INVALID TAN CODE

When saving your certificate, you could experience the following 3 errors:

1. Network Error: You will not be able to save your certificate if you are not connected to the network. To proceed please make sure you are connected to the network.
2. TAN code error (wrong code): Make sure the code you enter in the CovPass Cyprus app is the same as the one shown on your certificate. If the TAN code is the same, please refer to point 3 below.
3. TAN code error (duplicate): If you already have your certificate stored on a smart device you will not be able to reinsert the same TAN code. In this case, please follow again the process by visiting the EUDCC portal to issue a new certificate that will contain a newly generated TAN code and try again. Or, if the certificate which has been already saved in your device, the QR code can be scanned by another device and submit the TAN code.

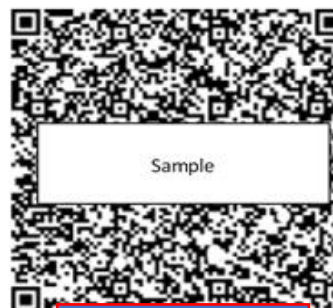

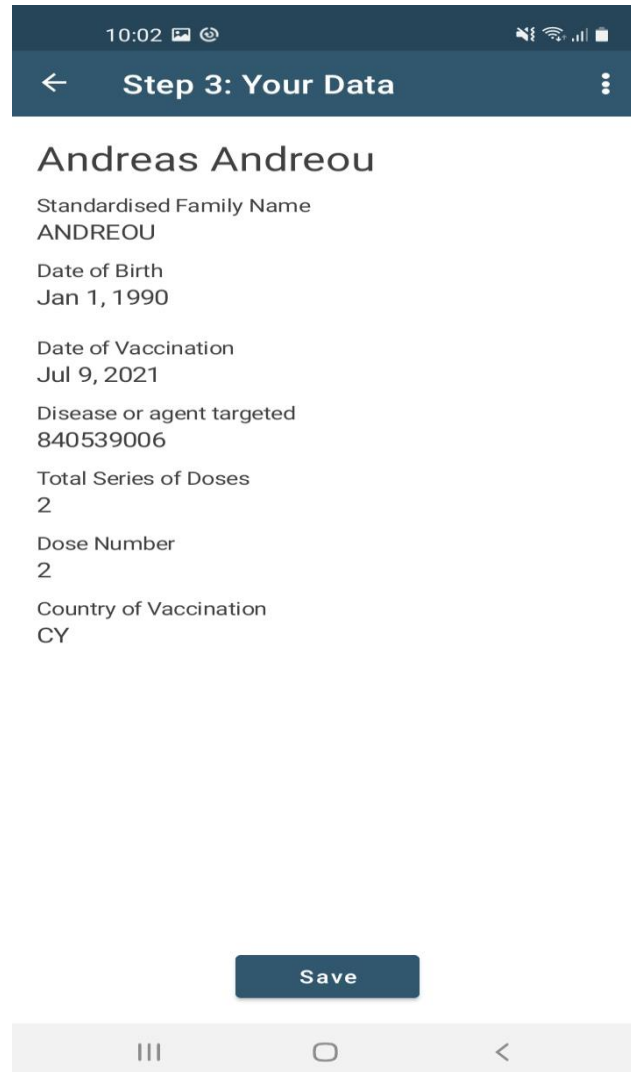

STEP 3: PRESENTATION OF THE CERTIFICATE DETAILS

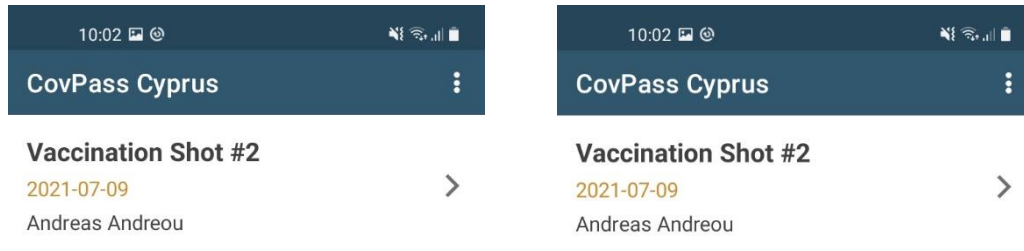
After successfully inserting the TAN code, your personal details will appear. Make sure that they are correct and press **“Save”** to save the certificate on your smart phone.

STEP 4: SUCCESSFUL STORAGE OF CERTIFICATE

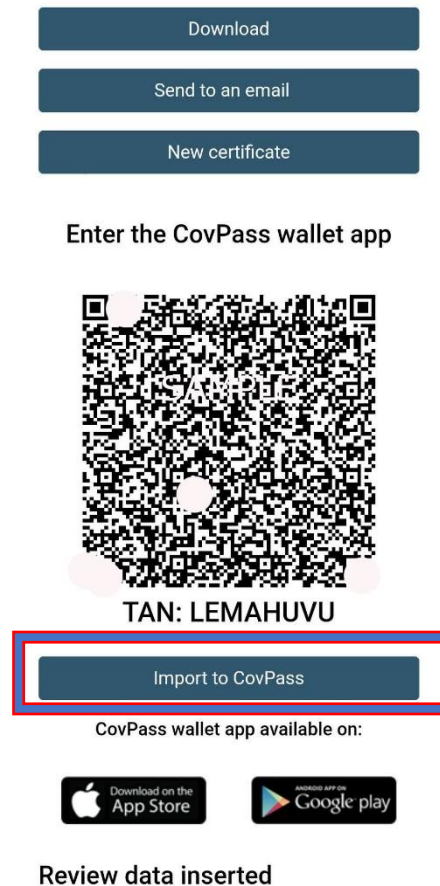
At this point you have successfully saved your certificate on the CovPass Cyprus application.

AUTOMATICALLY STORE THE CERTIFICATE TO COVPASS CYPRUS

If you are using the same Android device to issue the certificate you can automatically store it to the application CovPass Cyprus by choosing the function «**Import to CovPass**». Then, the CovPass Cyprus after submitting the personal security code will be open to save the certificate.
